

The Three R's

Responsibility:

1. **Bring everything you need to class each day.**
 - Writing materials
 - Textbooks
 - Notebook/Mead book
2. **Be in your seat by the beginning bell. Unless told otherwise, leave it only after the ending bell rings.**
 - Keep the doorway clear
 - Tardiness recorded
 - The first one up is the last one out
3. **Hall passes will be given only during seat work.**
 - Pass requests should be infrequent
 - No passes during exams
4. **Students are responsible for checking missed assignments** due to illness, athletic events, etc. Homework assignments and related materials can be obtained by clicking on the "faculty" link on the school home page at mvrhs.org. Click on my name and then click on your class link on my site. Late assignments will be reduced one grade per class day from the original performance grade. After five days, no credit will be given.
5. **Honesty is the best policy.** All homework is to be done individually unless specified in writing on the assignment sheet. Cheating on exams or plagiarism will result in a ZERO for that assignment with NO MAKE UP.
 - Plagiarism is the act of *representing someone else's ideas or words as your own*. An example is cutting or "lifting" selected phrases, sentences or paragraphs from the Internet without quoting or citing the source.
 - Talking during exams or quizzes must be considered evidence of cheating.
6. **Wear clothing that does not obstruct either your ability to learn, or my ability to teach.**
 - Please remove hoods, eye wear, etc. upon entering class.
